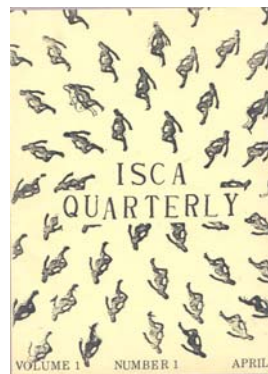

**Fluxus Films:** In its first DVD festival, as part of Fluxus Redux in July, 2005, **art6** presented films by Richmond filmmakers in three categories. Selected for viewing during the exhibition were:

- 1) ANIMATION: **Easter Parade** by **Maura Pond**.
- 2) SHORT NARRATIVE FILM: **The Oatmeal Incident** by **Todd Andrew Raviotta**. From **The Short Films of Todd Andrew Raviotta**.
- 3) FEATURE LENGTH ART DOCUMENTARY: **Art ex Libris** by **Mitzi Humphrey**. Co-producer **Michael Moore**. Converted from video format by **Doug Hayes**.



In September, 2005, **art6** held its first **Latin American Film Festival ¿Que Pasa?** The festival was led by **Dr. Consuelo Navarro**, a new member of the **art6** Executive Board. The films were selected and discussed by **Dr. Navarro**, Professor of Spanish and teacher in the Department of Languages, Literature and Film at Virginia State University in Petersburg. **Dr. Navarro** has a Ph.D. in Hispanic and Luso Brazilian Literature and Linguistics from the University of Minnesota.
